

## Articulation Agreement

This agreement is between  
**BIR Training Center (BIR)**  
and  
**Florida Memorial University (FMU)**

### Purpose of the Agreement

Through this articulation agreement BIR Training Center and Florida Memorial University express a shared commitment to providing increased opportunities for student access and success. By clarifying transfer policy and assuring a connectedness between targeted programs, the colleges seek to assist students in making a smooth transition to a baccalaureate program.

### Statement of Transfer Policy

Students who have earned any credits from BIR Training Center with a minimum grade point average of 2.0 will qualify for admission to Florida Memorial University. A maximum of 90 credits total may be transferred to Florida Memorial University. A minimum of 25% of the credit hours required for a student's degree must be earned by instruction at Florida Memorial University. The attached Course Sheet lists side by side the two BIR Accounting courses and the two Florida Memorial University Accounting courses which the parties deem to be equivalent courses, and thus accepted for transfer credit by Florida Memorial University if the student earned a grade of "C" or higher. Since the effective date of this Agreement, the courses listed on the attached Course Sheet have been and continue to be unconditionally accepted by Florida Memorial University. The school's dean and the Provost must approve all other transfer credits used toward a degree.


### Transfer of Credits


According to transfer policy at Florida Memorial University, a maximum of 90 Credits may be accepted in transfer. Pre-college or remedial courses and technical courses are not accepted in transfer. Florida Memorial University accepts courses earned at other post-secondary institutions, provided that the grade earned for these courses is a "C" or higher, the courses represent collegiate coursework relevant to the degree program being pursued at Florida Memorial University, the course content, level of instruction, and resulting competencies are equivalent to those of students enrolled at Florida Memorial University; and all official transcripts are submitted to the University for evaluation prior to the transfer student's admission to the University.

Certain prerequisites or matriculation condition are specific to certain majors as outlined in the program section of the undergraduate catalog of Florida Memorial University or as specified in targeted articulation areas included under this agreement.

Transfer students will be eligible for housing selection on the basis of their class standing. Transfer students will have access to financial aid resources and services on the same basis as other students.
